INTRODUCTION

As a Trustee you must be a person of integrity, honest, committed, and willing to learn and appreciate what being a Trustee involves. Reading the Retirement Benefits Act and Regulations therein, the Schemes Trust Deed and Rules and any of the regular pension's publications is an excellent way of understanding the expectation of Trustees and developments in the pensions industry. Among the key expectations of a trustee are to:

- Act in line with the Trust Deed and Rules
- Act in the best interests of the scheme members and beneficiaries.
- Act impartially.
- Act prudently, responsibly and honestly.

The duty to act prudently means you must act in the way that a prudent person would act in their own affairs. In doing so, you must use any skills and expertise you have to the benefit of the pension scheme. Trustee's duties are to the scheme, regardless of any other position you may hold. Your other duties or obligations or relationships to any group or individual must not influence your impartiality, prudence and honesty.

It is required that an aspirant for Trusteeship pass a fit and proper test.
